

CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL & CHEMICAL COMPLIANCE

Scope of Declaration. This declaration applies to products distributed by ASI and is based on current knowledge, supplier-provided material declarations and compliance documentation. ASI does not independently manufacture the underlying materials or perform routine chemical analysis of distributed products.

RoHS Compliance

ASI supports compliance with Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2), as amended by Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 and subsequent applicable amendments. To the best of our knowledge and based on supplier declarations, products covered by this declaration comply with applicable RoHS substance restrictions and maximum concentration values in homogeneous materials.

- Restricted substances include lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP, subject to applicable exemptions.
- ASI does not intentionally add RoHS-restricted substances to the products it distributes.

REACH and SVHC Compliance

ASI supports compliance with Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH), as amended. ASI distributes articles and does not intentionally supply substances intended for release from those articles.

- Based on supplier information available to ASI, substances on the ECHA Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), in effect as of the date of this declaration, are not known to be present above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) per article unless specifically disclosed.
- ASI maintains supplier communication and documentation processes to monitor applicable REACH and SVHC requirements.

EU Persistent Organic Pollutants (EU POPs / EPOP)

ASI supports compliance with Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), as amended. Based on supplier information available to ASI, products covered by this declaration are compliant with applicable restrictions for substances listed under the Regulation.

- POPs substances are not intentionally added where their use is prohibited or restricted.
- Where regulated substances may occur as unintentional trace contaminants, they are not known to exceed applicable concentration limits.

U.S. Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

ASI supports compliance with applicable requirements of the U.S. Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), including applicable restrictions promulgated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency under TSCA Section 6.

- Based on supplier information available to ASI, products covered by this declaration are not known to contain restricted persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals in concentrations or uses prohibited by applicable TSCA regulations.
- This includes applicable restrictions concerning DecaBDE, PIP (3:1), 2,4,6-TTBP, PCTP and HCBd, subject to regulatory exclusions, exemptions and permitted uses.

Substances of Concern – Relevant CLP Substances

ASI also reviews supplier-provided chemical compliance information for substances classified as hazardous under Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 on Classification, Labelling and Packaging of Substances and Mixtures (CLP), as amended, including relevant substances with harmonized classifications under Annex VI.

- Based on information provided by qualified suppliers, ASI is not aware of intentionally added relevant CLP substances of concern in products covered by this declaration at levels that would cause the product, as supplied as an article, to be noncompliant with applicable EU chemical restrictions.
- Because CLP primarily establishes classification, labelling and packaging requirements for substances and mixtures rather than a universal prohibited-substance list for articles, compliance is evaluated against the requirements applicable to the specific product and substance.

Basis and Limitations of Declaration

This declaration is based on current knowledge and supplier-provided information available as of the issuance date. Unless specifically stated otherwise, it does not represent independent laboratory testing by ASI. Regulatory lists and requirements may be amended after the date of issuance.

- This declaration does not apply to products modified by third parties.
- It does not cover unintended contamination, misuse, neglect, external damage or degradation not attributable to ASI.
- Product-specific test reports, full material declarations or supplier certificates may be provided separately when available or specifically
